



You are invited to present a poster at the Ecoconference 'Food in a New Climate' in Norrköping, 19-21 November 2007

Are you working on an exciting project or experiment within organic farming? Take the opportunity to present it at the major poster display to be held on 20 November during the Ecoconference in Norrköping. The Ecoconference, which is held in alternate years, attracts around 500 visitors from the entire Swedish food supply chain and provides excellent opportunities to communicate your research to an interested public, receive feedback on your thoughts and ideas and establish important contacts. This year the conference will also have an English language component on global themes, providing the opportunity to establish contact with international actors. If you have recently begun your project, your poster can be very simple, with a description of the objectives and the project structure. To submit a poster, you must submit a normal application to attend the conference. The programme and application form will be available at www.cul.slu.se from the end of June.

For those participating in the poster presentation, the following instructions apply:

- Each poster will be allocated an area of 100 cm x 100 cm.
- By **1 October** at the latest, a written summary of the poster for the conference proceedings must be sent as an e-mail attachment to Karin.Ullven@cul.slu.se. As a safety precaution, a hard copy of the page must also be posted/faxed to Karin Ullvén, CUL, SLU, Box 7047, SE 750 07 Uppsala/fax 018-67 35 71. Name your file according to the principle: surname_forename_text.doc and surname_forename_fig.jpg
- The summary must be in Swedish or English and comprise max. one A4 page (~ 2500 characters). If the summary contains e.g. tables, the amount of text must be reduced to make space for these. Your name, telephone number and e-mail address and the project name and relevant Department/company or similar must be included in the text. The layout of the material will be altered, so it is important not to make permanent hyphenations, page or line breaks. Mark headings and subheadings with bold – if possible use only one level of subheading.
- Figures must be sent as separate graphics files (e.g. jpg, tif or eps) – and thus should not be embedded in the text. If you send Excel figures, the entire calculation sheet with all data must be included. Figures will be printed in black & white, so if you send figures in colour there is a risk of light shades such as yellow and pink disappearing completely in print!
